The Role – The Line Cook is responsible for preparing, cooking and serving a variety of meals according to regular or special diets for individuals admitted to this residential mental health care facility. The Line Cook works under the direction of the Dietician.

Minimum 2 years experience as a cook, preferably in a health care facility with exposure to therapeutic diet preparation.
