



GO GREEN TIPS AND TRICKS

Ensure that appropriate recycling boxes are available in boardrooms and that meeting chairpersons advise staff and guests on the proper disposal of plates, cans and bottles. Make sure to check which items property management will take responsibility for recycling. Ask one or two workers to volunteer to recycle left over recyclables and advocate for property management to develop a more extensive recycling program.

Choose to have lunch meetings catered by companies that provide reusable dishes. If this service is not available in your area, advocate for change by speaking to the managers of the catering companies you use. If you continue to receive paper plates and napkins, make change happen and pick up a staff set of dishes from the local thrift store.

Commit to the simple things: drive less, turn off lights and use reusable shopping bags and bins. Every little bit helps.

When appliances need replacing, purchase energy efficient toilets, taps and light fixtures. This saves money and energy.

Buy toilet paper made of recycled materials.
