



REQUEST TO ADDRESS THE BOARD

The CLBC Board of Directors meets six times a year on a regularly scheduled basis to fulfil its responsibility of guiding the organization's short and long-term success. At each meeting the Board must address a lengthy agenda.

The CLBC Board welcomes any person wishing to attend meetings as an observer, and also sets aside time at the beginning of each Board Meeting to hear public presentations and to answer questions from the public. Due to space limitations, seating is available at the meeting on a first come first served basis.

In order to ensure that the Board hears from all wishing to make a presentation, the time allotted for each presentation is ten (10) minutes. The Chair may extend this time limit at his/her discretion.

The total time for all Q&As and Public Presentations will be limited to 45 minutes. Requests to present to the Board or to have questions answered are addressed in the order in which they are received. The Board Chair may call for an early termination of the time set aside for hearing from members of the public, at his/her sole discretion.

The Board believes that others may share our interest and your interest in the information you wish to present. A written summary of your presentation will be included in our [Board Minutes](#).
