Forum on Aging	<p>Jule and Kim introduced themselves and provided a brief background on their work history. They distributed information on the proposed forum on aging</p> <p>CLBC is aware that there are many individuals and families who are getting older and acknowledges that there many more people who are not connected to CLBC who are also aging</p> <p>The purpose of the forum is to bring all those people together to share information, concerns and experiences</p> <p>Jule and Kim would like to partner with the community council to host the forum. The council would be responsible for arranging the location and for distributing the invites. The invites should be distributed to a diverse population, including the university, the faith communities, the aboriginal communities, the legal system, etc. Jewel and Kim cover the costs of the forum and will facilitate for the purposes of listening and gathering the information. They will develop a work plan from the information obtained</p> <p>The community council approved the partnership and recommended that there be three forums – one in Langley, one in Abbotsford and one in Chilliwack.
