They will have guest speakers and refreshments. Self-Advocates are also planning a dance in November.</li> <li>• Barb Warkentine advised that PG Riding is coming to the</li> </ul>

end of the season. The horse show on September 12 was great with over 30 riders. Lots of families were reached. Cariboo Observer carried a story. Quesnel branch of BC Therapeutic Riding Association is having a workshop regarding Autism. Tickets are \$55.00 (lunch provided); members of Therapeutic Riding receive a discount. VELA workshop in Prince George last weekend had 25 attendees with some new people. Spectrum held workshop "101 Ways to Make New Friends", collected people's stories for a book and had a parent panel sharing their experiences. Barb reported on CLAN, which provides backup support for non union Microboards approaching government. CLAN is associated with Spectrum. Therapeutic Riding is selling tickets for \$20.00 for a Pub Night on October 25 at Riverstone Pub.

- Jenny Jones said there was a parents meeting in September. AiMHi is invited to next meeting in October to provide information on AiMHi services. Baseball has two new provincial teams. Jenny shared about Kelowna tournament. Excellent fundraising was done. It provided a great opportunity to mingle. Jenny will attend next meeting in Vancouver on October 17. Downs support group starts up on Monday. A person in Vernon is starting a group called BC Downs Syndrome Connection to lobby government for funding.
- Kris Zemplak advised AiMHi is very busy. Preparing for CARF (Canadian Association of Rehabilitative Facilities) survey, Members will be attending in Boston to share Performance Improvement report. She talked about Summer Rec Program and Spectrum Workshop. A need for activities to include community as a whole has been identified. She also advised that 70 people from Prince George went on Alaskan cruise.
- Bonnie Fallowfield mentioned increase to Autism funding, her participation in FSI training, Safeguards workshops, AIDP (Aboriginal Infant Development Program); recruitment of younger parents, supporting other families and helping Vickie and Jean. Bonnie's son has been writing letters of invitation to Quesnel officials. Bonnie read out Bev's resignation as well as Bonnie's response. Pat sent her regards to Bev.
