Review of previous meeting minutes & Introductions	<p>Meeting minutes examined by the council, and Maggie Metcalf expressed the need for correction. **BC Housing**

Brenda Gillette requested BC Housing's presence at the meeting to foster worthwhile communication regarding how to receive social housing assistance and receive info. regarding new development in social housing. Deanna Bhandar, the senior project officer of development services spoke about the community partnership initiative (CPI) whereby BC Housing has partnered with non-profit societies, government agencies and community organizations to increase the supply of housing options for low and moderate income households across BC.

Brenda Gillette inquired about rental subsidies that some individuals were historically receiving, and not able to obtain anymore. Brenda also expressed concern regarding high risk individuals who do not meet CLBC criteria, yet still require residential support.

Micheal Anhorn, regional operations manager of BC Housing replies he is unaware of any current rental subsidies and may have been sporadic support that no longer exists. Kathy MacDonald asks if there are currently subsidized housing through BC Housing. Micheal replies there is very few rental subsidies available.

Micheal explains the rental assistance program provided through BC housing for single adults or families is a good resource for individuals, and the amount is determined at 30 percent of one's income. Micheal states the two key issues include long waitlists and eligibility issues (people receiving income assistance are not eligible for Rental Assistance Program.)

Deanna expresses the need to get creative in order to provide residential services. For example she has connected with Kate Lister at Creative Center Society in Chilliwack which is in the process of building an 8 unit apartment building in Chilliwack. This was achieved through real estate grants and funding through BC Housing.

Brenda Gillette and Maggie Metcalf also expressed concern regarding the negative aspects of placing marginalized individuals in one building which ultimately increases the stigma of those with developmental disabilities. Micheal agreed and says BC housing is creating memorandums of understanding with individual buildings in hopes to tackle this issue.

Maggie also expressed the issue of vulnerable individuals having unsuitable living arrangements which poses a safety risk.
