#### 1) What's the Buzz?

- > BCACL Rachelle reported on the June meeting
  - Focus on employment. Supportive employment should be considered for individuals that are transitioning to adults services.

- > CACL at BCACL office is holding a workshop on aging on July 11, 2008.

  - Transition John and Brenda met with VSB and discussed Goal Based Planning. Discussed the last Transition Group Meeting, minutes were distributed. VSB and CLBC are working on improving working relationship.
  - Transition Fair To be discussed at next meeting.
