CLBC will be providing updates to service providers. Most service providers are still doing covid safety protocols to ensure we keep our vulnerable individuals as safe as possible.   CLBC will continue to have teleconference call for individuals and families with Dr. Behn Smith, Deputy Provincial Health Officer. CLBC will be sending invitations on this call.
