The service is intended to capture those travel times when handydart service is not available.</p> <p>Sunshine Coast is also in need of expansion on handydart or other possible transport service. We have individuals that live outside the current bus service route.</p> <p>There is also a discussion on inclusive housing and support programs. Social housing permits are delayed. Construction is also delayed due to covid and budget constraints.</p>
