

## Comparing Agency Coordinated Home Sharing and Host Agency Agreements

Find below a description of the features of CLBC agency coordinated home sharing and CLBC host agency agreements for home sharing. Note that both home sharing and live-in -support services are referred to as home sharing in this document.

Model:	Agency Coordinated Home Sharing	Host Agency Agreement for Home Sharing
Availability	This model is widely available with service providers across B.C.	There are a limited number of service providers providing this model and it may not be available in some communities.
Contract	A pre-qualified service provider, or agency, receives funding directly from CLBC to coordinate the services of, and pay, a home sharing or live-in support provider, in accordance with the Standards for the Coordination of Home Sharing.	A tri-party contract between CLBC, the Agent (you), and the Host Agency (selected prequalified service provider). The Host Agency receives funding directly from CLBC to coordinate the services of, and pay, a home sharing or live-in provider, in accordance with the Standards for the Coordination of Home Sharing
Home Study	The agency's Home Sharing Coordinator conducts home studies and ensures living arrangements meet the Home Sharing Standards.	Same process as the agency coordinated model
Oversight and Support	The agency manages all roles and responsibilities associated with overseeing, supporting, and coordinating the home sharing (includes quarterly monitoring visits, ensuring safety and quality of life for the person supported, ongoing support for the home sharing provider, recruitment, etc.). The agency works collaboratively with the person and their family/support network for person-centred planning and feedback on the services.	The same as agency coordinated home sharing plus: In partnership with the Host Agency, the Agent holds responsibilities, and provides input, related to the delivery of the person's supports and services; outlining goals that will be achieved along with indicators of success; the communication of information; the monitoring of services and other responsibilities as required.
Family & Support Network	Family members and support network of the supported person maintain their existing relationship with the home sharing provider.	Same as the agency coordinated model
The transition for this option	Transition your home sharing service from your contract to a pre-qualified CLBC-contracted service provider in your community who you prefer and have selected. You would no longer handle the funding or coordination pieces.	Transition your home sharing service from your contract to a pre-qualified CLBC-contracted service provider in your community for a tri-party contract between CLBC, the Agent (you), and the Host Agency (selected pre-qualified service provider). You would no longer handle the funding pieces but may be involved in some of the coordination pieces
Home Sharing Provider Selection	Upon successful completion of a home study, the home sharing provider remains the same. If the home sharing provider is no longer available, the agency is responsible for recruitment and involves the person and their family/support network in the matching and selection process.	Same as the agency coordinated model
