3. Member Roundtable

Each PAC member shared an update about what their respective Councils are working on, as well as membership and recruitment needs. Some highlights noted were:

- Held Valentine's Day dance and presentation from Nanaimo Self Advocacy group Central Island Council
- Hosting connection and information sharing event on Wednesday May 31st in Fort. St. John. Helping to present and promote Welcome Workshops *North Council*
- Planning a 'making and maintaining healthy relationships' event, BBQ picnic event, and partnering with community theatre to host monthly autism friendly nights. Invited local Fire Chief to present to the Council and gathered resources for emergency preparedness *North Okanagan Shuswap*
- Hosted a Joint In-Person event to bring two Councils together to share ideas and plans for the following year. Visited local social enterprise "Potluck Café Society". Vancouver Council was asked by the City of Vancouver to continue assisting with the Vancouver Accessibility Work Plan Vancouver Council and North Shore Sunshine Coast Council
- Hired a student to do research about accessible and inclusive housing. Working on community mapping and planning to hire a contractor to support self-advocates to present about inclusive housing to local housing and municipal groups – *Thompson* Cariboo Council
- Working on recruitment, community picnic, and identifying continuing issues: Ageing, Housing and Transparency *Simon Fraser Council*
- Working on an In-Person annual general meeting, planting "Tree of Rights", and new Trail Self Advocacy Group Kootenay Council
- Continuing Council member education by hosting speakers at meetings (such as ex-Nidus and representation agreements). Partnering with Upper Fraser Council and the Indigenous Community to host drumming and smudging event – Surrey/White Rock/Delta Council

4. <u>CLBC Updates from Chief Executive Officer Ross Chilton and Vice President, Governance and Communications, Randy Schmidt</u>

- There are positive changes with the Community Living Authority Act:
 - The Community Living Authority Act will require the CLBC Board to have a minimum of two individuals eligible for CLBC – one family member and one Indigenous member
 - The Community Living Authority Act will require the CLBC Board to have an Indigenous Advisory Committee

- Jessica Humphrey received a promotion. Her new title will be "Manager, of Community Engagement". Jessica will hire someone to assist with supporting PAC and the Community Council
- Community Living BC is designing a new Crisis Prevention and Response Service. The Design Team can join the May or June Council meeting to discuss your ideas about the design. If the Council members are interested, please notify Jessica Humphrey
- Community Living BC received a budget increase and raised the Individual and Family Core Funding
- The BC CEO Network received a grant from CLBC to assist with recruiting more people to join the Community Living field
- The Ministry announced an increase for shelter for individuals on PWD of \$125.00/month
