Nomination Rules and Instructions

- All nominations must be completed on the official nomination form.
- Photos help tell the story about your nominee. We encourage photos to be submitted but they are not required.
- Telephone and email information for both nominator and nominee is required in case the Selection Committee needs additional information, or so we can contact winners and their nominees.
- Winners' and their nominees' names will be published on the CLBC website, social media channels and in the Celebrate Diverse Abilities newsletter.
- All submitted photos must include a waiver signed by the people in the photo.
- All photos submitted with nominations and from WOW events may be used in future CLBC print and online materials, and will be posted on the WOW webpage.

How to submit your nomination

Online Nomination

1. Identify the person you want to nominate
2. Take a photo of how they are building inclusion in your community
3. Visit www.communitylivingbc.ca/wow to find a link to the online nomination form and photo waiver. There is a section at the end of the form where you can upload a photo.
4. Have any people in your photo sign the online waiver form.
5. It's that easy!

Mail or Fax Your Nomination

1. Pick up a nomination form at your local CLBC office or print it from the WOW website.
2. Identify the person you want to nominate
3. Take a photo of how they are building inclusion in your community
4. Have any people in your photo sign the waiver at the bottom of the next page.
5. Email your photo with your name, the nominee's name and your community in the Subject line to: wowclbcawards@gov.bc.ca – and then...
